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.5- providing facilities to the Engineer Co-operative Societies and Labour Contract Co-operate Society.

The Committee went through the proposal of the Committee of Chief Engineers to review the facilities allowed to the Co-operative Societies and decided to continue the present practice. Any further concession/ benefit to the Co-operative Societies as suggested by the Registrar, Co-operative Societies will be additional financial burden to the State exchequer. At present the State is passing through a severe financial hardship for which it is not desirable to extend further facilities to Co-operative Society and Labour Contract Co-operative society.

The Committee also decided to endorse this observation to the Registrar, Co-operative Societies and Co-operation Department of Government for favour of reference.

Clarification to the Works Deptt. Circular No. 10003/W Item No.6dt. 21. 5. 2001.

> The Committee discussed pros and cons on the doubts raised in different quarters in regard to the Works Deptt. Circular No. 10003 dt. 21. 5. 2001 and observed as follows:-

Doubts.

- 1. Whether the Engineer Contractors can participate only in three tenders without E.M.D. irrespective of the fact whether they are successful in the competition or not.
- to participate in tenders restriction of nos. of chandes can enter into only three contracts with-out E.M.D. & I.S.D.

Observation

- 1. Engineer Contractor can participate in three tenders without E.M.D. in a financial . year. The question of success in the competition has no relation with this exemption of E.M.D.
- 2. Whether they will continue 2. As stated above, an engineer contractor can participate without E.M.D. without any only in three tenders without restriction of nos. of E.M.D. during a financial year. For participating in more than three tenders during a financial year the

Engineer Contractor has to deposit the E.M.D. as per provision.

- 3. Whether the fact of 3. Examption of E.M.D. will be entered in the Original Registration Certificate of the engineer contractor at the time of participating in the tender.

- 4. Whether the terms "Awarding 4. The term "Awarding a work with a work with exemption of E.M. D. " means execution of works contractors or includes participation in tenders without E.M.D.
- 5. Whether another facility of 5. The facility of award of "Popularly known as "award of print" to Engineer , contractors for a maximum amount of Rupees two lakhs per year without tender with benefit of exemption of E.M.D. and I.S.D. still remains in force or this benefit stands wi thdrawn.

exemption of E.M.D. " as mentioned in the Works Deptt. Circular No. 10003 dt. 21. 5. 2001 means participation in tender without E.M.D.

work to angineer Contractor for a maximum amount of Rs. 2.00 lakhs per year without tender with banefit of E.M.D. & I.S.D. is still in force.

The Committee also decided to intimate this observation to proper quarter for favour of their reference.

Item No.7. Clarification on award of works to the Engineer Contractor. The Committee went through the doubts raised by the

Committee of Chief Engineers and observed as follows: -

- 1. The benefit of award of work as per the works Deptt. Circular No. 292 dt. 4. 1.92 is also applicable for the Graduate Engineer enlisted as 'A' Class and Diploma Holder enlisted as 'B' Class.
- 2. Award of works up to &. 2.00 lakhs and B. 1.00 lakh to Graduate Engineer having 'A' Class licence and Diploma Holder having 'B' Class licence respectively in a financial year at current schedule of rate without calling tender is still in force.

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
