Sir,

In continuation to these letters under reference it is observed that some of the Executive Engineers in Water Resources department are not following the instructions therein. It is clearly stated that Ist of all the gate works should be awarded to Mechanical Divisions/ M/s O.C.C.Ltd. or by floating tenders to registered S.S.I Units with good infrastructure and credentials like work experience and expertise in the line.

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While floating tenders for the above works, eligibility norms/ qualifying criteria are to be included in D.T.C.N. and Bid documents as per rules like (i) Satisfactory completion of work at least one or two Nos of similar type gate works of suitable equal value. (ii) The annual financial turn over in respect of gate works executed along with infrastructure, expertise and experience of firms and S.S.I Units are to be considered. For the gate works to be executed under critical conditions the single stage double Bid system can also be incorporated while tendering to ensure quality and timely completion of works.
