Subj: Revision of bid capacity clause as qualification criteria in the DTCN. Bid capacity clause as qualification criteria in the DTCN as follows. These stipulations shall apply to the DTCN as all works above Rs. 3 Crores with immediate effect.

Applicants who meet the minimum qualification criteria will be qualified only if their available bid capacity at the expected time of bidding is more than the total estimated cost of the works. The available bid capacity will be calculated as under:

Assessed Available Bid Capacity = (A*N*2-B), where Assessed Available Bid Capacity = A

A= Maximum value of works executed in any one year during the last five years (updated to the current price level) rate of inflation may be taken as 10 percent per year (escalation factor) which will take in to account the completed as well as works in progress.

B= Value of current price level of the existing commitments and ongoing works to be completed during the next years (Period of completion of works for which bids are invited), and

N= Number of years prescribed for completion of the works for which the bids are invited.

Note: In case of a joint venture, the available bid capacity will be applied for each partner to the extent of his proposed participation in the execution of the works.

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The statement showing the value of existing commitments and ongoing works as well as the stipulated period of completion remaining for each of the works listed should be countersigned by the Engineer-in-Charge not below the rank of an Executive Engineer.
