Instructions for execution of additional works as part of a continuing work.

Sir,

I am directed to say that it was instructed in Deptt. of Water Resources Letter No. 21567 dated 18.6.99 that before taking up any additional works through an existing agreement prior approval of Government should be taken with sufficient justification in conformity with the provisions under para 3.5.9. of the O.P.J.D. Code Vol. I and proposals for such permission should be routed to the Department through the E.I.C.W.R. Only after prior approval is accorded by Government detailed deviation statement may be submitted to Government with due recommendations of the P.L.C as per instructions contained in DCWR letter No. 23416 dated 17.3.94.

Instances have come to the notice of Government that in spite of the above instructions some project Officers are getting executed additional works as part of the original work through the existing agency without prior approval of Government by way of deviation and submitting deviation proposals for post facto approval. Such a practice is not in conformity with the codal provisions and is irregular.
