#### NOTIFICATION

The 3rd August, 2018

**S.R.O. No. 326**/2018 — In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (b) of sub-section(1) of Section 3 read with Section 4 and sub-section (1b) of Section 5 of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 (11 of 1948), the State Government do hereby make proposals for fixing / revising the minimum rates of wages as specified in Column (4) of the Schedule hereto annexed payable to the categories of employees as mentioned in Column (3) thereof, who are employed in the employments as specified in Column (2) of the said Schedule, for the whole State of Odisha. The proposals are hereby published as required by clause (b) of sub-section (1) of Section 5 of the said Act, for information of all persons likely to be affected thereby and notice is hereby given that the said proposal shall be taken into consideration on or after the expiry of a period of two months from the date of publication of this notification in the *Odisha Gazette*.

The revised minimum rates of wages shall consist of the rates of wages as set out in Column (4) of the said Schedule and payable to the categories of employees as mentioned in Column (3) thereof. In addition to the said rates of wages Variable Dearness Allowance (VDA) as admissible shall be declared every six months rather than annually i.e. on 1st April and 1st October of the year.

Any representation containing objection or suggestion which may be received by the Principal Secretary to Government, Labour & E.S.I. Department, Odisha, Bhubaneswar-751001 from any person in respect of the said proposal before expiry of the period specified above will be considered by the State Government.

Explanation: for the purpose of this notification-

- 1. The minimum rates of wages are all inclusive rates including the basic rates, the cost of living allowances and the cash value of the concessional supply if any of essential commodities.
- 2. The daily minimum rates of wages shall be inclusive of wages payable for the weekly day of rest.
- **3.** The minimum rates of wages are applicable to employees employed by contractors also.
- **4.** The minimum rates of wages for disabled persons shall be same as payable to the workers of the appropriate category.
- 5. There shall not be any discrimination between male and female workers in the matters of payment of minimum wages in any category of employment.
- **6.** (a) "Unskilled" work means work which involves simple operation requiring little or no skill or experience on the job.
  - (b) "Semi-skilled" work means work which involves some degree of skill or competence acquired through experience on the job and which is capable of being performed under the supervision or guidance of a skilled employee and includes un-skilled supervisory work.
  - (c) "Skilled" work means work which involves skill or competence acquired through experience on the job or through training as an apprentice or in a technical or vocational institute and the performance of which calls for initiative and judgment; and
  - (d) "Highly Skilled" work means work which calls for a high degree of performance and full competence in the performance of certain tasks, acquired through intensive technical or professional training or practices, work experience for long years and also required for workers to assure full responsibility for the judgment or decisions involved in the execution of these tasks.
- **7.** An adult employee shall work for 08 (eight) hours per day excluding half an hour of rest.

#### NOTIFICATION

Whereas the minimum rate of wages for un-skilled, semi skilled, skilled and highly skilled categories of employees in 89 scheduled employments were fixed/revised by the Government in Labour & ESI Department Notification No. 7312-LL-I(III)-56/18/LESI dated the 30.10.2018 published in the Extraordinary issue No. 1991 of the Odisha Gazette dated the 30.10.2018 bearing SRO No. 431/2018.

And whereas, the State Advisory Board in its 52<sup>nd</sup> meeting have advised to adopt a system of revision of Variable Dearness Allowances (VDA) @ Rs. 0.90 per point rise in the Consumer Price Index (CPI) Number for Industrial Workers (base 2001-100) as admissible shall be declared at half yearly, interval i.e. on 1<sup>st</sup> April & 1<sup>st</sup> October from the date of notification of revised wages, to be effected from 1<sup>st</sup> April of 2020.

Accordingly, the Variable Dearness Allowance @ Rs. 0.90 paisa per point rise in All India Consumer Price Index Number (Base 2001-100) needs to be effected from 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2020 for the points rose during the preceding six months i.e. from October 2019 to 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2020.

Now therefore, I Dr. N. Thirumala Naik, I.A.S, Labour Commissioner, Odisha in exercise of the powers delegated to me in the aforesaid Notification do hereby notify that the special allowance called as Variable Dearness Allowance @ Rs.5.40 shall be payable per day to the un-skilled, semi-skilled, skilled & highly skilled categories of employees in all 89 scheduled employments (list enclosed) in addition to the minimum rate of wages notified vide Labour & ESI Department Notification as cited above w.e.f. 01.04.2020.

Accordingly, the present rate of minimum notified wages including VDA with effect from 01.04.2020 will be specified as under.

Whereas the minimum rate of wages for un-skilled, semi skilled, skilled and highly skilled categories of employees in 89 scheduled employments were fixed/revised by the Government in Labour & ESI Department, Odisha vide Notification No. 7312-LL-I(III)-56/18/LESI dated the 30.10.2018 and published in the Extraordinary issue No. 1991 of the Odisha Gazette dated the 30.10.2018 bearing SRO No. 431/2018.

And whereas, the State Minimum Wages Advisory Board in its 52<sup>nd</sup> meeting have advised to adopt a system of revision of Variable Dearness Allowances (VDA) @ Rs. 0.90 per point rise in the Consumer Price Index (CPI) Number for Industrial Workers (base 2001-100) as admissible and shall be declared at half yearly, interval i.e. on 1<sup>st</sup> April & 1<sup>st</sup> October from the date of notification of revised wages, starting from 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2019.

Accordingly, the Variable Dearness Allowance @ Rs. 0.90 per point rise in All India Consumer Price Index Number (Base 2001-100) needs to be effected from 1<sup>st</sup> October, 2020 on the basis of the average consumer price index number for the preceding period of six months ending on 30.06.2020 reaching 329.17 from 324 and thereby resulting in an increase of 5.17 points.

Now therefore, I Dr. N. Thirumala Naik, I.A.S, Labour Commissioner, Odisha in exercise of the powers delegated to me in the aforesaid Notification do hereby notify that the special allowance called as Variable Dearness Allowance @ Rs.4.65 shall be payable per day to the un-skilled, semi-skilled, skilled & highly skilled categories of employees in all 89 scheduled employments (list enclosed) in addition to the minimum rate of wages notified vide the above noted Notification of Government in Labour & ESI Department, Odisha w.e.f. 1<sup>st</sup> October, 2020. Accordingly, the present rate of minimum notified wages including VDA per day (after rounding off) w.e.f. 1<sup>st</sup> October, 2020 will be as under:-

#### The 6th October, 2012

No.8536–LL-I(AR)-2/12/LESI. –Whereas certain proposals to revise the minimum rates of wages payable to certain categories of employees employed in 83 employments were published as required under clause (b) of sub-section (1) of Section 5 of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 (11 of 1948) in the Extraordinary issue No. 785, dated the 23rd April, 2012 of the *Odisha Gazette* under the notification of the Government of Odisha in the Labour & E.S.I. Department No.3146–LL-I-(AR) 2/12/LESI., dated the 20th April, 2012 inviting objections and suggestions from all persons likely to be affected thereby within a period of two months from the date of publication of the said notification in the *Odisha Gazette*.

And, whereas, the representations containing objections and suggestions received within the specified period of two months in respect of the said draft have been duly considered by the State Government and the Advisory Board appointed under section 7 of the said Act, has also been consulted.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause(b) of sub-section (1) of Section 3 read with Section 4 and sub-section (2) of Section 5 of the said Act and in supersession of all previous notifications issued in this regard the State Government do hereby revise the minimum rates of wages payable to the Unskilled, Semi Skilled, Skilled, Highly Skilled categories of employees employed in 83 employments as mentioned in the schedule to this notification in the whole State to ₹ 150.00, ₹ 170.00, ₹ 190.00 and ₹ 205.00 per day respectively. In the case of Agricultural Sector of the Schedule of employment, ₹126.00 and ₹ 150.00 shall be paid as daily wages to the Non-Ploughing and Ploughing Workers respectively. In addition to the said rate of wages, a special allowance called as Variable Dearness Allowance shall be payable @ ₹ 2.50 (Rupees two and paise fifty) only per day for every 50 point rise in the All India Consumer Price Index Number

(Base 2001-100) for industrial workers or on the expiry of every block period of two years from the date of coming into force of this notification whichever is earlier as may be notified by the Labour Commissioner, Odisha in the official gazette of the State and the same shall be uniformly applicable to the categories of employees specified above to be effective from the date as may be directed by the Labour Commissioner, Odisha in the said notification.

It is further directed that this notification shall came into force on date of its publication in the *Odisha Gazette*.

- (d) "Highly Skilled" work means work which calls for a high degree of performance and full competence in the performance of certain tasks, acquired through intensive technical or professional training or practices, work experience for long years and also required for workers to assure full responsibility for the judgment or decisions involved in the execution of these tasks.
- 7. An adult employee shall work for 8 (eight) hours per day excluding half an hour of rest.

Whereas the minimum rate of wages for unskilled, semi skilled, skilled and highly skilled categories of employees in 89 scheduled employments were fixed/ revised by the Government in Notification No. 7312-LL-I(III)-56/18/LESI dated 30.10.2018 of the Labour & ESI Department, Odisha published in the Extraordinary Issue No. 1991 of the Odisha Gazette dated the 30.10.2018 bearing SRO No. 431/2018.

And whereas, the State Minimum Wages Advisory Board have advised to adopt a system of revision of the special allowance called Variable Dearness Allowances @ Rs. 0.90 per point rise in the Consumer Price Index Number for Industrial Workers (Base 2001-100) as admissible and shall be declared at half yearly interval i.e. on 1<sup>st</sup> April and 1<sup>st</sup> October from the date of notification of revised wages, starting from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2019.

And whereas, the Variable Dearness Allowance for the half year commencing w.e.f. 1<sup>st</sup> October, 2022 is required to be effected on the basis of the increase in average Consumer Price Index Number for Industrial workers reaching 365.76 from 357.65 as on 30.06.2022 and thereby resulting in an increase of 8.11 points.

Now therefore, I Dr. N. Thirumala Naik, I.A.S., Labour Commissioner, Odisha in exercise of the powers delegated in the aforesaid Notification do hereby notify that the Variable Dearness Allowance (VDA) @ Rs. 7.00 per day (after rounding off) shall be payable to the unskilled, semi-skilled, skilled and highly skilled categories of employees in all 89 scheduled employments (list enclosed in the Schedule) w.e.f. 1<sup>st</sup> October, 2022 in addition to the minimum rate of wages notified vide the aforesaid Notification of Government in Labour & ESI Department, Odisha and the total VDA notified vide Notification No. 2433/ LC dtd. 30.04.2021. Accordingly, the present rate of minimum wages including VDA per day w.e.f. 1<sup>st</sup> October, 2022 shall be as under:

Whereas the minimum rate of wages for unskilled, semi skilled, skilled and highly skilled categories of employees in 89 scheduled employments were fixed/ revised by the Government in Notification No. 7312-LL-I(III)-56/18/LESI dated 30.10.2018 of the Labour & ESI Department, Odisha published in the Extraordinary Issue No. 1991 of the Odisha Gazette dated the 30.10.2018 bearing SRO No. 431/2018.

And whereas, the State Minimum Wages Advisory Board have advised to adopt a system of revision of the special allowance called Variable Dearness Allowances @ Rs. 0.90 per point rise in the Consumer Price Index Number for Industrial Workers (Base 2001-100) as admissible and shall be declared at half yearly interval i.e. on 1<sup>st</sup> April and 1<sup>st</sup> October from the date of notification of revised wages, starting from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2019.

And whereas, the Variable Dearness Allowance for the half year commencing w.e.f. 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2023 is required to be effected on the basis of the increase in average Consumer Price Index Number for Industrial workers from 365.76 to 378.58 as on 31.12.2022 and thereby resulting in an increase of 12.82 points.

Now therefore, I Dr. N. Thirumala Naik, I.A.S., Labour Commissioner, Odisha in exercise of the powers delegated in the aforesaid Notification do hereby notify that the Variable Dearness Allowance (VDA) @ Rs. 12.00 per day (after rounding off) shall be payable to the unskilled, semi-skilled, skilled and highly skilled categories of employees in all 89 scheduled employments (list enclosed in the Schedule) w.e.f. 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2023 in addition to the minimum rate of wages notified vide the aforesaid Notification of Government in Labour & ESI Department, Odisha and the total VDA notified vide Notification No. 6078/ LC dtd. 19.10.2022. Accordingly, the present rate of minimum wages including VDA per day w.e.f. 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2023 shall be as under:

Whereas the minimum rate of wages for unskilled, semi skilled, skilled and highly skilled categories of employees in 89 scheduled employments were fixed/ revised by the Government in Notification No. 7312-LL-I(III)-56/18/LESI dated 30.10.2018 of the Labour & ESI Department, Odisha published in the Extraordinary Issue No. 1991 of the Odisha Gazette dated the 30.10.2018 bearing SRO No. 431/2018.

And whereas, the State Minimum Wages Advisory Board have advised to adopt a system of revision of the special allowance called Variable Dearness Allowances @ Rs. 0.90 per point rise in the Consumer Price Index Number for Industrial Workers (Base 2001-100) as admissible and shall be declared at half yearly interval i.e. on 1<sup>st</sup> April and 1<sup>st</sup> October from the date of notification of revised wages, starting from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2019.

And whereas, the Variable Dearness Allowance for the half year commencing w.e.f. 1<sup>st</sup> October, 2023 is required to be effected on the basis of the increase in average Consumer Price Index Number for Industrial workers reaching 385.97 from 378.58 as on 30.06.2023 and thereby resulting in an increase of 7.39 points.

Now therefore, I Dr. N. Thirumala Naik, I.A.S., Labour Commissioner, Odisha in exercise of the powers delegated in the aforesaid Notification do hereby notify that the Variable Dearness Allowance (VDA) @ Rs. 7.00 per day (after rounding off) shall be payable to the unskilled, semi-skilled, skilled and highly skilled categories of employees in all 89 scheduled employments (list enclosed in the Schedule) w.e.f. 1<sup>st</sup> October, 2023 in addition to the minimum rate of wages notified vide the aforesaid Notification of Government in Labour & ESI Department, Odisha and the total VDA notified vide Notification No. 2500/ LC dtd. 05.04.2023. Accordingly, the present rate of minimum wages including VDA per day w.e.f. 1<sup>st</sup> October, 2023 shall be as under:
