I am directed to say that the question of forfeiture of E.M.D. where a tenderer backs out from the offer before acceptanc of tender was under consideration of Govt. for some time past.

After careful consideration it has been decided that a provision may be incorporated inthe DTCN having penal implication for forfeiture of E.M.D. if the tenderer backs out from the offer be fore acceptance of the tenderer by the competant authority.

This has been concured in by law department & finance Department in their U.O.R. No. 848 L dt. 31. 5. 97 J.O.R. No 202 WFD dt.6.3.98 pespectively.
