

Copy of the letter No. 9100 dt. 30.3.98 from F.A.-cum-joint secretary to Government, Works Department addressed to E.I.C. (Civil) Orissa, Bhubaneswar/ Chief Engineer, Roads, Orissa, Bhubaneswar/etc. etc.

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Sub:- Forfeiture of E.M.D. in cases where a tenderer backs out from the offer before acceptance of tender.

I am directed to say that the question of forfeiture of E.M.D. where a tenderer backs out from the offer before acceptance of tender was under consideration of Govt. for some time past.

After careful consideration it has been decided that a provision may be incorporated in the DTCM having penal implication for forfeiture of E.M.D. if the tenderer backs out from the offer before acceptance of the tenderer by the competent authority.

This has been concurred in by law department & finance Department in their U.O.R. No. 848 L dt. 31.5.97 J.O.R. No 202 WFD dt. 6.3.98 respectively.
